Join us for a sneak preview of the new designs for Govan Old Entranceway and find out more about the exciting community dig in the churchyard!

As part of current public realm improvements being funded by Central Govan Action Plan and Glasgow City Deal, designs for public realm improvements leading from Govan Road to Govan Old Church were developed in consultation with local people.

The works include:

- Replacing the existing tarmac pathway with reclaimed stone setts and paving
- Reinstating the churchyard's original Victorian lamp standards
- Feature lighting illuminating access to Govan Old and Pearce Institute
- Creation of a reflective space with new seating around the Govan War Memorial
- New signage and gate piers to welcome visitors to Govan Old and the Govan Stones

Drop in any time between 1pm and 4pm. Short talks from 1pm - 1.30 pm followed by a tour of the site by landscape architect Richard East. All welcome.
